De derde steunpilaar van de bundel is het lange essay 'J=Kunst in tijden van ontredde', waarin Houellebecq een bijna boeddhistische onthechting lijkt te bepleiten: 'Ieder individu kan in zichzelf een soort koude revolutie teweegbrengen, door zich een moment lang buiten de informatief-publicitaire stroom te plaatsen.'
